

A Guide to the AAUW Florida Website

AAUW Florida website – www.florida-aauw.org

Home page: The AAUW mission statement is in italics across the top of the page. The Line(s) underneath the 130 year anniversary logo highlight the most recent state or AAUW event or news.

The first part of main portion of the page describes state activities for newcomers to the site, non-members and AAUW members from out-of-state.

The second portion of the page will highlight significant branch activities and links to some AAUW items.

The AAUW logo on the upper left is a direct link to the AAUW Home page.

The list below is on the left side of this page and most other pages of this website.

About AAUW : Provides basic information about AAUW and includes the membership requirements, the mission statement, value promise and a brief description of each of the AAUW Funds and the AAUW Action Fund.

Calendar: Lists dates important to AAUW Florida members - both state and national dates.

Members' Center: Serving on the AAUW Florida State Board, Dues information, updating your membership information, Who is eligible to serve as a Leader-on-Loan, basic convention information, link to AAUW Mission & Action e-News, Board Members Responsibilities, AAUW Florida Bylaws, AAUW Florida Website Policy, AAUW online History Museum.

Branch Locations: Florida map showing geographic regions. Branches are listed by area of state and alphabetically by branch including region and county where branch is located. Click on any branch name to view that branch's website page.

Branch page: Description of the area served by the branch, size of branch, newsletter name, list of interest groups, list of officers, About Us, Regular meeting location and time, calendar of events, link to current newsletter and website if branch has one, and local area links.

Branch and State Newsletters: A list of branch newsletters that are sent to the Webmanager. Listed alphabetically by branch. Click on one to read the most recent newsletter. At the bottom of the page are the next FloriVision deadline, information about submitting items to FloriVision and links to current and past issues of FloriVision.

Communications: Links to Communications committee, website policy, current and back issues of FloriVision, and submission requirements for FloriVision and the website.

State Convention: Date and location of convention. Names of speakers, titles of workshops, program schedule, directions to make hotel reservations and directions to the hotel, and convention registration form, deadlines for hotel and convention registrations, etc.

Educational Opportunities: Another list of the various AAUW Funds; current AAUW fellowship and grant recipients names with university name and degree that they are working towards and a history of the Educational Opportunities Fund.

Forms: A list of all Florida forms, the Florida bylaws and the Florida 2010-2012 Public Policy Program, direct links to the AAUW Contribution, Give-a-Grad-a-Gift and Honorary Life Membership forms. The link to the AAUW Branch forms leads to the AAUW Member Center Login. At the bottom of the page is another link to the AAUW Member Center Login.

Legal Advocacy Fund: It's purpose, importance of contributions and list of currently supported LAF cases, some of which have links to descriptions of the case, links to the LAF Update and LAF Express and a list of top 2010 Florida branch contributors to LAF.

Membership: Links to the Member Get A Member Campaign, Give a Grad a Gift, Membership Pilot Program, Membership Matters, the e-newsletter for Membership VPs, Member Center, the AAUW Online Museum and Member Benefits as well as links to the Florida branch locations page and the state Membership Committee.

Program: Link to the list of Programs in a Box on the AAUW Site and the Member Center, sample list of available Programs in a Box, brief descriptions of Leader on Loan Program, Who should enroll as a Leader-on-Loan, description of the Mini-Grant program, the STEM-Pay Equity Mini-Grants and Creative Writing Contest. Also links to other AAUW Programs, and the state program committee.

Officers: List of AAUW Florida Elected Officers, Appointed Officers, State Committees, and Past Presidents.

Public Policy: Links to sign up for the Action Alerts, to the Two-Minute Activist, the AAUW Research Reports, sample bookmark listing local legislators, the AAUW Florida 2010-2012 Public Policy Program, The AAUW 2011-2013 Public Policy Program, sign up for Washington Update, the most recent legislative alerts, The Washington Lobby Corps, the AAUW Position Papers and the State Public Policy Committee.

International Affairs: Links to a variety of international organizations concerned with bettering the lives of women all over the world. Some have a single focus such as poverty, discrimination, etc. Included is a link to the AAUW International Corner.

Resource Links: Women and Social Movements in the US; the AAUW Site; Florida Universities and School Systems, Florida Government, Local Florida Counties and Communities, the US Government and Political Parties, Media and Women's issues.

Each page shows the month and year it was last updated and a link to the web manager's email address in order for anyone to send new information, a message about errors or links that no longer work. Sending emails about errors and links that no longer work is critical to their getting corrected promptly.
